

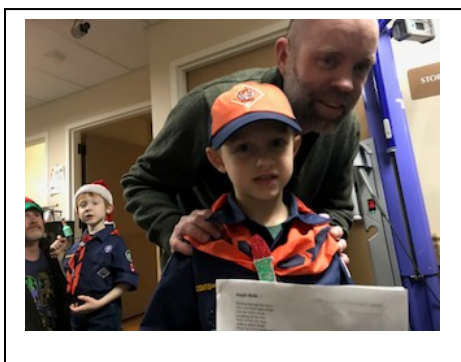
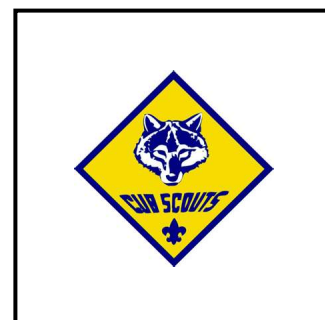
Join the Cub Scouts of *Pack 266** at Good Shepherd for camping, hiking, crafts & more
